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Back Ups or Ponding?

BAFFLE REPAIR

Each septic tank is equipped with two baffles that were attached to the tank at the manufacturer. These original baffles were made of concrete much like the tank. Over time the concrete baffle will decompose from the effects of constant moisture and corrosive sewer gases. Baffles retain the floating solids in the septic tank where the natural bacterial action decomposes and liquefies the waste. The liquefied wastewater then leaves the outlet side of the tank and enters the dispersal zone (drain field, leach bed, etc.). Damaged outlet baffles cause backups, ponding and reduces the life expectancy of the dispersal zone.

Don't Want to Dig Out the Cover?

SEPTIC TANK RISERS

Because septic tanks are buried underground, locating and accessing tank lids for inspection and pumping can be a potentially difficult, time consuming and a costly endeavor. A simple addition of a septic tank riser provides an easy, cost effective solution to this problem that will provide long-term savings. Do You Have a Filter?

FILTER CLEANING

Effluent Filters are installed in front of your septic tanks outlet and create a screen barrier between the inside of the tank and the drain field. Over time, the filtered solid waste can build up on the filter reducing efficiency. Neglecting a clogged effluent filter could lead to large, expensive problems. You could end up spending thousands of dollars replacing your system. It's a terrific idea to clean your filter at least every 6 months to a year. We can help you keep your system in tip top shape. Older System/Tough Clogs?

AUGERING

Augering is the process of blockage removal with the use of a mechanical device, consisting of a motor drive, cable and cutting bit. Some clogs can be difficult to remove such as roots, hair, grease, wash cloths, fabric diapers, feminine products, etc. Augering is used in place of jetting when these blockages are suspect. Augers work great in hard to reach areas such as sewer pipes. The flexible cables will negotiate tight bends in traps and floor drains.

PRESSURE JETTING
